

Amlodipine/irbesartan

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Gastric cancer: case report

In a retrospective study, an 80-year-old man* was identified, who developed gastric cancer during a combination treatment containing amlodipine and irbesartan. The man, with essential hypertension, was receiving treatment with a combination tablet containing amlodipine 10mg and irbesartan 100mg [*route not stated*]. He was diagnosed with gastric cancer 13 weeks after starting the combination medication [*outcome not stated*].
