The first sentence of the first paragraph of section 3.2 should read:

The time to first AUR or BPH-related surgery was significantly longer with combination therapy versus tamsulosin (p < 0.001); there was no significant difference between combination therapy and dutasteride (p = 0.18). The first sentence of the second paragraph of section 3.2 should read:

When AUR and BPH-related surgery were considered separately, time to first event was significantly longer with combination therapy versus tamsulosin (p < 0.001).
